I am directed to refer to this Department's letter No. 18-3/2021-MIDH (i) dated 27.04.2021 about the administrative approval for implementation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme on Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH) under Green Revolution - Krishonnati Yojna and to convey the sanction of the President of India to the payment of an amount of ₹ 20,00,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Crore only) to Government of Tamil Nadu during 2021-22, for implementation of the Scheme in Tamil Nadu.

2. This assistance under the scheme is in the ratio of 60:40 by Central Government and State Government respectively.

3. In accordance with the revised procedure, the Reserve Bank of India may please be advised for debiting to the Account of the Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers Welfare and passing on the credit to the Central Account Section, Nagpur, for transfer to the State Government of Tamil Nadu.


4. The said Grants-in-aid will be subject to the following conditions: -

(a) The grants shall be utilized and disbursed by the concerned implementing agency in accordance with the MIDH Operational Guidelines, Annual Action Plan/Administrative Approval for the year 2021-22 and in accordance with the conditions stipulated in this letter.

(b) The implementing agency shall maintain proper accounts of the expenditure incurred and submit the statement of audited accounts and Utilization Certificates to this Department as soon as possible after the close of the financial year.

(c) The audited records of all assets (permanent or semi permanent) acquired wholly or substantially out of the grant to the implementing agency should be maintained as prescribed in General Financial Rule 2017 and shall be furnished to the Government of India annually by the end of June, following the financial year to which it relates.

- (i) All grantee institutions shall submit Utilization Certificates in prescribed proforma (GFR-12A) on PFMS [Rule 86(6)].
- (j) The Further use of Grants in Aid being released by this sanction Order, is to be done through EAT module of PFMS.
